INTLREG Electronic Certificates

International Register of Shipping (INTLREG) has launched Electronic Certificates fully compliant with the IMO "Guidelines for the Use of Electronic Certificates". The INTLREG electronic certificate has online certificate verification feature using Quick Response (QR) Codes and Unique Tracking Number. The electronic certificates are issued from 1 November 2020. The existing paper certificates issued by INTLREG prior to this date remain valid. However, we encourage all vessels owners/ managers to convert old paper certificates to electronic certificates during subsequent surveys. You may send your request to the local INTLREG survey station / office

The electronic certificates issued by International Register of Shipping is prepared as per FAL.5/Circ.39/Rev.2 dated 20 April 2016 - The IMO Guidelines for the use of Electronic Certificates.

Certificate Number/ Tracking

All electronic certificates issued by International register of Shipping are with unique tracking number (Certificate number) as per the guidelines of IMO, an identifier can able to distinguish an electronic certificate issued by our society.

The E-certificates have Quick Response (QR) code and verification link, which can be verified by anyone through internet. The verifying means a reliable, secure and continuously available to confirm the authenticity and validity of an electronic certificate using the unique tracking certificate number.

Verification of Electronic Certificates

All Electronic certificates issued by International Register of Shipping will be with QR code and a hyperlink for certificate verification. The document should be considered an electronically signed document according to IMO FAL.5/Circ.39/Rev.2.

To verify the certificate, scan the QR code on the certificate using any QR code scanner application, it will take to the certification verification page and will show whether certificate is valid or not.


